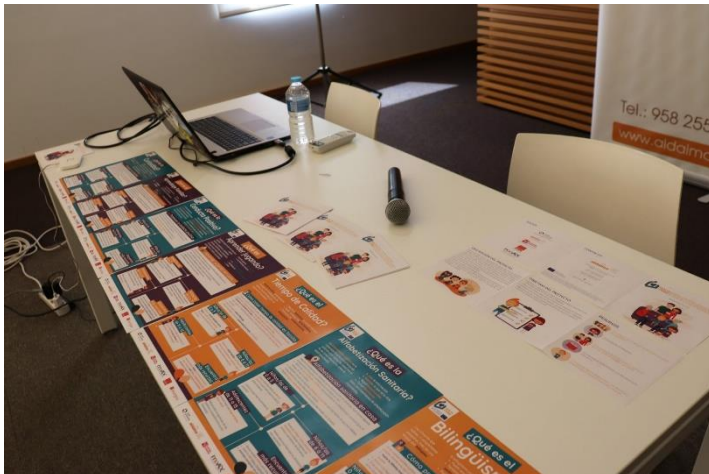


Health@Home Summer Series:
